





DESCRIPTION

Water is a crucial element for life, essential for the survival of humans, animals, and plants. However, global climate change, increasing demand for freshwater, and inefficient infrastructure threaten hydrological security. Access to clean water has improved, but still over 2 billion people live in areas at risk of water scarcity.



Water scarcity and poor sanitation conditions lead to millions of deaths annually, hinder economic and social development, and impede access to education.

By 2050, approximately 25% of the world's population will live in areas with chronic water scarcity. Investments in water resource management and sanitation infrastructure are crucial.

MAKE CITIES AND HUMAN SETTLEMENTS INCLUSIVE, SAFE, RESILIENT, AND SUSTAINABLE.



DESCRIPTION

The urban environment impacts our well-being and socio-economic development. However, cities, which occupy only 3% of Earth's surface, are responsible for 60-80% of energy consumption and 75% of CO2 emissions. Therefore, by becoming active members of our local communities, we can address the challenges of rapid urbanization.



By 2030, the urban population is expected to grow to 5 billion. This requires urban planning that can manage urbanization without excessive resource consumption.



By promoting sustainable development, we should ensure access to services and housing, manage waste effectively, protect the environment, and reduce poverty.

DESCRIPTION

The main causes of climate change are greenhouse gas emissions, which increase Earth's temperature. This results in extreme weather conditions, conflicts over water, and mass migrations. Education is a key tool that teaches how to counteract these changes.



Climate change affects the entire world, but it is the poorest countries and the most vulnerable social groups that are primarily affected by its consequences.



Effective solutions include transitioning to renewable energy sources and global cooperation is crucial in limiting temperature rise and supporting countries' adaptation to climate change.

is the increase in the average global temperature since the Industrial Revolution. Further increases will lead to water shortages, heatwaves, and agricultural losses, which will contribute to rising food prices.

EUROPEAN UNION

EU countries with the highest emissions are Germany, France, Italy, Poland, and Spain. 77% of greenhouse gas emissions in the EU come from the energy sector,

POLAND 400 mln tons

of greenhouse gases are released into the atmosphere annually. This accounts for 9.8% of the total emissions in the EU. Poland ranks 7th among the largest emitters of gases per capita in the EU.



CONSERVE AND SUSTAINABLY USE THE OCEANS, SEAS, AND MARINE RESOURCES FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT.



DESCRIPTION

Oceans and seas, covering about 75% of the Earth's surface, are essential for human life, providing necessary quantities of, among other things, rainwater, food, and oxygen, as well as regulating weather and climate. However, their natural state and biodiversity are threatened by human activities, such as pollution, overfishing, and ocean acidification caused by increased CO2 emissions.



Rising water temperatures, changes in ecosystems, and threats to fisheries require regulations to limit pollution, overfishing, and to manage marine resources effectively.



46% of key marine areas are protected, but careful and sustainable management of the oceans is still needed, as they are also important trade routes.

97 %

of the world's water is contained in the oceans. They absorb 30%of the CO2 produced by human activities, helping to mitigate the effects of global warming.

EUROPEAN UNION

730 tons

of waste are dumped into the Mediterranean Sea every day. Of this, 27% consists of plastic components from fishing gear, while 49% are single-use items such as bottles, caps, cotton swabs, cutlery, and straws.

POLAND

304,000 tons

of fish are caught annually in the Baltic Sea, with 90% being herring and sprats. Currently, 6,000 fishing vessels operate in the area and must comply with the catch limits set by the European Commission.

Take care of the environment while sailing, fishing, or kayaking.



Save water. Reducing water usage lessens the burden on wastewater treatment plants, which improves the quality of marine waters.



Use eco-friendly cleaning products to limit the release of harmful chemicals into groundwater and eventually into the oceans.



Participate in public consultations on biodiversity and support the creation of marine reserves.





Organize local clean-up events for beaches, rivers, or lakes.

Support organizations working for clean oceans by making a donation or becoming a volunteer.

When organizing events, use tableware and cutlery made from biodegradable materials such as bamboo, palm leaves, paper, or cornstarch.



Educate employees about marine environmental protection, promoting ecofriendly behaviors both at work and in their personal lives.

CONSERVE AND SUSTAINABLY USE THE OCEANS, SEAS, AND MARINE RESOURCES FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT.



DESCRIPTION

Forests, covering nearly one-third of the Earth's surface, are crucial for biodiversity, food security, and combating climate change. They are home to most terrestrial fauna and flora. Despite increasing protection efforts, global forest cover has decreased by 2.4% since 2000, with ongoing trends of degradation and desertification threatening ecosystems and humanity.



Human activities leading to deforestation and land degradation threaten air and water quality and impact food sources, with negative consequences for life on Earth.



The rate of deforestation has decreased from 7.8 million hectares per year in the 1990s to 4.7 million hectares currently. Protected areas have increased from 30% to 44%, offering hope for improved management and protection of the natural environment.

of land that could be used to grow 20 million tons of grain are lost each year due to drought and desertification. 74% of impoverished populations are directly affected by land degradation.

EUROPEAN UNION 26 %

of the land area in the EU is protected. In 2013, this figure was 18.9%. Although the pace of creating new protected areas has slowed, the EU is on track to achieve the 30% target by 2030.

POLAND 29,6 %

of Poland's land area is covered by forests. This is 5.9% more than in 1995. The national reforestation program aims to increase forest cover to 33% by 2050.



POLAND 695 milion PLN

was allocated to Poland by the European Commission to assist Ukrainian refugees fleeing the country due to the ongoing war.
