
WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

All children in the world should go to school, learn to write, read, and explore the world. Education helps us dream big and make those dreams come true! 🧦






WHAT DOES IT MEAN?


WHAT DOES IT MEAN?


We need energy for light, heat, cooking, and many other things. But we should use energy from sources that don't pollute, like the sun, wind, or water. That's what clean energy means.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?


Every person, no matter what they look like, where they come from, whether they have a disability or speak another language, deserves to be treated with respect and have the same rights.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?


Cities and villages should be clean, safe, and well-organized. Everyone has the right to a home, parks, safe transportation, and clean air.



WHAT DOES IT MEAN?



1 LIFE ON LAND






WHAT DOES IT MEAN?







Together, we can do more!






